



STD/HIV Home Specimen Collection Kit 60 Sec PSA

The Alabama Department of Public Health has a new STD/HIV Specimen Collection and Laboratory Test Kit Initiative that allows individuals ages 12 and older to do STD/HIV testing privately – and even in the comfort of their own homes.

The purpose of this initiative, now in its second phase, is to promote STD/HIV testing among individuals at home to strengthen the STD/HIV prevention and control program in Alabama.

The STD/HIV Specimen Collection and Laboratory Test Kit is free. Each kit includes supplies to collect blood from a fingerstick, urine, and other collection sites, and the specimen collection kit is then mailed back to the laboratory for processing.

Alabama residents – including college and university students – will be able to request one STD/HIV specimen collection and lab test kit every three months, and kits will be mailed directly to patients.
