Test (All test must be FDA approved)	Initial Prenatal Visit	Third Trimester	Labor and Delivery (L&D)
<b>Syphilis</b>	All pregnant persons.	All pregnant persons at 28-32 weeks gestation.	All pregnant persons.
<b>HIV</b>	All pregnant persons not previously confirmed as HIV infected.	All pregnant persons at 28-32 weeks gestation, regardless of risk factors unless previously confirmed as HIV infected.	All pregnant persons unless already confirmed as HIV infected.
<b>Chlamydia</b>	All pregnant persons.	All pregnant persons at 36 weeks gestation if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The initial test was positive,</li> <li>• Signs or symptoms present, or</li> <li>• At high risk of infections</li> </ul>	Only if no prenatal care.
<b>Gonorrhea</b>	All pregnant persons.	All pregnant persons at 36 weeks gestation if: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The initial test was positive,</li> <li>• Signs or symptoms present, or</li> <li>• At high risk of infections</li> </ul>	Only if no prenatal care.
<b>HBV</b>	All pregnant persons.		All pregnant persons.
<b>HCV</b>	All pregnant persons.		Only if no prenatal care.

## No Prenatal Care –Patient Presents at Delivery

Test	Labor and Delivery
<b>Syphilis</b>	All pregnant persons.
<b>HIV</b>	All pregnant persons unless already confirmed to be infected with HIV infection.
<b>Chlamydia</b>	All pregnant persons.
<b>Gonorrhea</b>	All pregnant persons.
<b>HBV</b>	All pregnant persons.
<b>HCV</b>	All pregnant persons.
