CITY OF BRENT ORDINANCE PROHIBITING TOBACCO USE IN RECREATIONAL SETTINGS

CITY OF BRENT TOBACCO FREE ORDINANCE

Be it ordained by the City of Brent, Brent, Alabama, this Article shall be known as the City of Brent Tobacco Free Ordinance.

The following rules and regulations shall apply in all municipal settings located within the City of Brent.

Smoking shall be prohibited in all of the following areas without exception.

1. Enclosed Areas- meaning all space between floor and ceiling that is enclosed on all sides by permanent or temporary walls or windows (exclusive of doorways) which extend from the floor to ceiling.

 Playground-meaning any park or recreational area designed in part to be used by children that has play or sports equipment installed, or that has been designated or landscaped for play or sports activities, or similar facility located on public or private school grounds, or on City of Brent grounds.

3. Sports Arcna- meaning sports pavilions, stadiums, baseball fields, soccer fields, football fields, softball fields, gymnasiums, health spas, boxing arenas, swimming pools, roller and ice rinks, bowling alleys, and other similar places where members of the general pubic assemble to engage in physical exercise, participate in athletic competition, or witness sports or other events.

Violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor in the City of Brent and shall be punished in accordance with the misdemeanor ordinance of the City of Brent.
