| <p style="text-align: center;">Top (Shirt)</p> <p>White, Navy Blue, or Royal Blue (solid color) Oxford Shirt or Polo Shirt (collared knit shirt or turtleneck) (Central School logo & logos smaller than quarter size allowed) Undershirts – solid navy or white (no wording or pictures) Vest – same solid colors as shirts, length must be to the waist or no longer than 3 inches below the belt All shirts must be tucked in (girls and boys)</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Bottom Khaki or Navy Blue</p> <p>Girls – Pants, Skirts, Capris, Shorts, Skorts, Jumpers, or Dresses (no more than 3 inches above the knee in front and back) (corduroy fabric permitted)</p> <p>Boys – Pants or Shorts (corduroy fabric permitted) No pockets on bottoms except those made into the side seams of the clothing, with the exception of back pockets (no extra pockets)</p> <p>(Pants cannot be more than two inches above actual waistline size) (Pants leg must be worn outside of shoe) (Pants leg must not be rolled up) (Brown is not considered Khaki)</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Jackets/Coats Sweaters/Sweatshirts</p> <p>Black, Navy, Gray, White, Royal, or Brown (solid color) No text or pictures (Central School logo & logos smaller than quarter size allowed) Must be worn with a uniform shirt</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Shoes/Tennis Shoes</p> <p>Black, Brown, Navy, Tan, Gray, or White The majority of the shoe color should be one of the colors above. Must be closed toe and closed heel Shoelaces must be one color as specified above Shoelaces must be tied and straps must be fastened.</p> |
| <p style="text-align: center;">Belt</p> <p>Black or Brown (solid color) Must be plain, unobtrusive buckle (no more than 3x3 inches) and appropriate length Must be worn with bottoms that have belt loops</p> | <p style="text-align: center;">Socks/Hose/Tights</p> <p>Black, Brown, Navy, Tan, or White</p> |
| <p>Items Not Allowed</p> <p>Wind pants/sweatpants, velour pants, over-sized clothing, overalls, bellbottoms, extra pockets on clothing, unhemmed clothing, clothing with cuts, slits, holes, or slashes, cargo pants, denim or jean fabric, sleeveless shirts, overcoats, trench coats, sunglasses, head coverings inside, house shoes, sandals, high heels (over 2 inches), pierced jewelry is limited to the ears, jewelry outside of clothing, necklaces that extend past the shirt neckline, earrings can be no longer than two inches.</p> | |
