STUDENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please read carefully and understand the following:

1. Students arriving at school prior to the 7:45 a.m. warning bell should get their books and report to their 1st period class. Do not roam the halls or visit other classrooms.
2. Students are not to leave campus after arrival unless excused from the office.
3. All food and drinks are to be consumed in the cafeteria or lobby area. Food and drinks are not to be taken to other areas of the campus.
4. Students are not to bring cigarettes or tobacco products to school. Smoking and the use of tobacco products are prohibited and may result in suspension.
5. Students are not to have a knife or any type of weapon in their possession on any Linden City School campus.
6. Any student using drugs or alcohol or having them in his/her possession on the school campus or at any school function will be suspended for the minimum of ten (10) days. This includes the transportation of drugs or alcohol to the campus.
7. No fighting. If you are having a problem with another student, see the principal. A three to ten day suspension will be imposed for fighting.
8. No cell phones, radios, boom boxes, tape recorders, "walkman" radios, pagers, electronic toys or games, or sunglasses are to be brought to school.
9. Students driving vehicles to school must be licensed drivers. Do not sit in vehicles on the campus upon arriving at school or during the day. The parking lot is off limits to all students during school hours. If you need to go to the parking lot, see the principal.
10. Students entering and exiting the parking lot are to drive cautiously. The speed limit is 5 mph. Violation of the rule may result in a suspension of school driving privileges.

11. Students cutting class or school will be suspended.
12. No student is to leave school without permission from the principal. Students riding buses are considered in school upon boarding of bus. Students are allowed to leave buses only at designated stops.
13. Students are not to bring or invite visitors to school. All visitors must report to the office.
14. Destruction of school property or vandalism will result in the violator being held liable for replacement or repair, plus suspension from school.
15. Breaking and entering a school building or violating school property will result in suspension. Law enforcement officials will be notified.

Violations of the above rules and regulations may result in suspension, except No. 5, No. 6, and No. 7 which will result in an automatic suspension and possible expulsion from school.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR

The following actions are prohibited. Any student displaying one or more of the behaviors will be disciplined.

1. Use of profanity.
2. Gambling.
3. Disrespect and insubordination to any school personnel, i.e., anyone working for the school board or who volunteers his services to the school, will result in suspension.
4. Possession of literature that would tend to cause disruption in school.
5. Possession and/or use of any article which disrupts the instructional program. Example: radio, tape player, fireworks.
6. Stealing and/or possession of stolen property. In such instances, law enforcement officials will be called.
7. Demanding money of another student by threat or coercion.
8. Loud talking, running, and pushing in the building.
9. Overt display of affection on campus.
10. Having hats, caps, or sunglasses on in the building.

It is fundamental that an orderly school have clearly defined behaviors to which students must conform. Non-conformity to these behaviors
