SMOKING POLICY

The University of West Alabama is committed to providing a safe and healthy environment for its employees and students. Because of the serious health hazards associated with smoking and being exposed to second-hand smoke, the University has implemented the following policy:

It is the responsibility of the dean, director, or other chief administrative officer to enforce the smoking policy in those buildings or portions of buildings under his or her control.

Appropriate areas where smoking may be permitted include smoking lounges, private, enclosed offices, grounds, and specified portions of the cafeteria. Any areas not designated as smoking areas are presumed to be non-smoking areas.

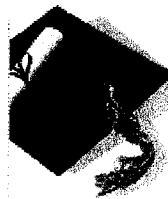
