Councilman Harmon Acker introduced the following Ordinance:

Ordinance 93-312

AN ORDINANCE FOR REGULATING THE USE OF
TOBACCO IN BUILDINGS OWNED, OPERATED OR LEASED
BY THE CITY OF ALABASTER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALABASTER,
ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances, City of
Alabaster, be amended by adding the following:

"Sec. 11-12 Tobacco products prohibited in city buildings.

It shall be unlawful for any person, whether
citizen, employee, or visitor, to use any tobacco
product in any building owned, operated, or leased by
the City of Alabaster.

Section 11-13 Same - penalty.

Any person violating the provisions of Section 11-12
shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each
offense."

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall become effective
upon its passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of
Alabaster, Alabama.
