ORDINANCE NO. 95- 64

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 11-9-10 OF THE GENERAL CODE OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, 1980, TO PROVIDE FURTHER FOR RESTRICTIONS ON SMOKING IN PUBLIC PLACES AND TO PROHIBIT SMOKING IN ALL CITY OWNED OR OPERATED BUILDINGS, VEHICLES OR OTHER FACILITIES.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section (e) of Section 11-9-10 of the General Code of the City of Birmingham, 1980, is hereby amended to read in full as follows:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke in a place of employment unless, in compliance with all laws and regulations, the employer, employer representative, or other person in charge or control of a place of employment has declared in a posted writing that smoking is allowed."

2. Section (i) is hereby added to Section 11-9-10 of the General Code of the City of Birmingham, 1980, to read as follows:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke in any City of Birmingham owned or operated building, vehicle, or other facility."

3. This Ordinance shall become effective on July 1, 1995.
