BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Brewton as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of Brewton has determined all of its building facilities located on Douglas Avenue in the City of Brewton where the new Municipal Complex and adjacent building are being constructed, should be declared entirely tobacco free.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City

Council of the City of Brewton, Alabama, in regular session assembled on the

11th day of June, 1996, at the City Hall in Brewton, Alabama, as follows:

- The City of Brewton declared all of its building facilities located on Douglas Avenue in the City of Brewton where the new Municipal Complex and adjacent building are being constructed to be entirely tobacco free.
- 2. The use of any tobacco products will be strictly prohibited in any building facility of the City of Brewton located on Douglas Avenue in the City of Brewton where the new Municipal Complex and adjacent building are being constructed, including, but not limited to, offices, hallways, class rooms, lobbies, restrooms and all other enclosed areas.
- 3. This prohibition against the use of any tobacco applies to all employees, visitors and all persons using said facilities.
- 4. Copies of this Resolution shall be distributed to all employees of the City of Brewton.
- 5. Tobacco free area signs or other similar messages shall be posted at all building entrances and throughout each building.
- 6. All employees and visitors shall share in the responsibility of adhering to and enforcing this Resolution.
- 7. Any complaint or violation should be brought to the attention of the Clerk of the City of Brewton and any employee who violates this Resolution will be subject to disciplinary action. Any visitor or other person who violates or fails to comply with this policy will be asked to leave the building or premises and warned that future non compliance will be considered a violation of the law and punishable under the same terms as a violation of state law.
