

ORDINANCE 26-94-95

WHEREAS, studies by the Surgeon General of the United States, the National Academy of Sciences, and other health organizations have linked passive exposure to tobacco smoke (second-hand smoke) to a variety of negative health considerations in nonsmokers; and

WHEREAS, the City of Guin finds that the use of all forms of tobacco, including cigars, cigarettes, pipes, and all chewing tobacco products negatively affects various activities within the City Hall, including the performance of duties by City employees, the conduct of City Court and other public meetings, carrying out of police, administrative, and civic activities, and the City wishes to eliminate the adverse affect of the same.

NOW, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GUIN, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to smoke or carry lighted tobacco and to chew or spit any tobacco product within any indoor portion of the Guin City Hall.

2. Any person violating the provisions of this Section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine in an amount not to exceed the sum of \$25.00.


