ORDINANCE NO. 533

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE SMOKING IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GULF SHORES, ALABAMA, WHILE IN REGULAR SESSION ON JUNE 24, 1991, as follows:

 $\underline{Section\ 1}.$ That, except as provided in Section 3. below, no person shall smoke in any building owned or under the control of the City of Gulf Shores, Alabama.

 $\underline{Section~2}.$ That such buildings shall be marked with clearly, sufficiently and conspicuously posted "No Smoking" signs and/or signs with the international "No Smoking" symbol.

<u>Section 3</u>. That the following areas are exempted from the requirements of this Ordinance:

- A. The main function room of the Erie H. Meyer Civic Center, while being rented for functions during which the Fire Marshal permits smoking;
- B. The Harry W. Roberts Community House, while being rented for functions during which the Fire Marshal permits smoking;
- C. The main function room of the Adult Activity Center, while being rented for functions during which the Fire Marshal permits smoking.

Section 4. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty (\$50) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the jail or at hard labor or community service for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment and/or community service at the discretion of the judge.

 $\underline{\underline{Section 5}}$. That this Ordinance shall become effective upon its adoption and publication as required by law.
