ORDINANCE M91-10-28

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MOODY, ALABAMA PROHIBITING THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN PUBLIC BUILDINGS OF THE CITY.

SECTION I USE PROHIBITED

No person shall smoke, chew, use snuff or any other tobacco products of any kind in the City Hall, Library, Fire Station, or other public buildings owned by the City of Moody, Alabama, except in designated areas.

SECTION II PENALTIES:

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not exceeding \$100.00. Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

SECTION III DESIGNATED AREAS:

The following are and shall be the designated areas for smoking:

1. The Police Day Room in City Hall
2. The Truck Bay area of the Fire Station

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage, approval and publication.
