

ORDINANCE

[To amend No Smoking Ordinance
to include "A Child's Place"
at Pratt Park.]

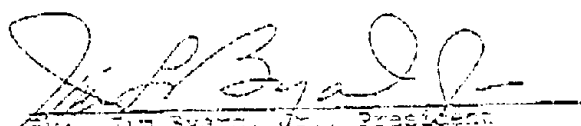
BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Prattville that Article IV Sec. 11-72 be amended and shall read as follows:

Except as provided in Section 11-73 and 11-74 smoking or the use of tobacco products is prohibited in any of the following public places:

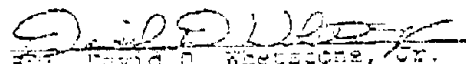
- (1) Any commercial establishment, including but not limited to retail stores, restaurants, banks, office buildings and offices;
- (2) Any vehicles of public transportation, including but not limited to local trains, buses, taxicabs and limousines;
- (3) Elevators;
- (4) Restrooms;
- (5) Libraries, schools or other educational facilities, museums, auditoriums and art galleries;
- (6) Any public area of health care facility, health clinics or ambulatory care facilities, including but not limited to laboratories associated with the rendition of health care treatment, hospitals (with the exceptions in patient rooms), rest homes, doctors' offices and dentists' offices;
- (7) Any indoor place of entertainment or recreation, including but not limited to gymnasiums, theaters, concert halls, bingo halls, arenas and enclosed swimming pools;
- (8) Any other enclosed area used by the public or serving as a place of work;
- (9) Hospitals may set aside designated lounge areas for smoking provided they follow the requirements of Section 11-74, designation of smoking areas. Hospitals shall accommodate nonsmokers by prohibiting smoking in all patient rooms, except where all the occupants thereof consent to smoking.
- (10) Any city owned or leased recreational facility within 5 feet of seating stands whether temporary or permanent in nature.
- (11) "A Child's Place" at Pratt Park, South of Dexter Street and West of Dexter Road and East of City Pool.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.
