ORDINANCE NO. 114-97

REALIZING THAT SMOKE FROM TOBACCO IN THE FORM OF CIGARETTES PIPES, OR CIGARS, HAS BEEN CONCLUSIVELY FOUND TO BE INJURIOUS TO HUMAN HEALTH, NOT ONLY TO THE PERSON SMOKING, BUT ALSO TO THE NON-SMOKER WHO IS REQUIRED TO BREATHE SUCH CONTAMINATED AIR.

The City Council of the City of Samson intends by the adoption of this Ordinance to protect the health and atmospheric environment of the non-smoker by regulating smoking in certain public areas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAMSON, ALABAMA:

SECTION ONE: It shall be unlawful for any person to smoke or carry lighted tobacco, in any form, in any of the following areas, except as may otherwise be herein permitted:

(1) City Hall; (2) Police Station; (3) Fire and Rescue Building; (4) Community Center; (5) Public Library; and (6) Any area of business or professional establishment, opened to the public which has been designated by clearly visible signs as a non-smoking area by the owner or the person in charge of such establishment.

SECTION TWO: Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine in an amount not to exceed the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
