AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN CITY BUILDINGS AND CITY VEHICLES; ESTABLISHING DESIGNATED TOBACCO USE AREAS, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS, AND OTHER MATTERS WITH RESPECT THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Scottsboro as follows:

That as it is in the public interest to promote the general health and safety of the city's employees as well as the general public and to provide a healthful environment for each and every municipal employee as well as visitors to a municipal workplace this ordinance is adopted as follows:

Section 1. The smoking or use of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, or the use of any tobacco product, smokeless or otherwise, is prohibited in all buildings and vehicles owned, operated, or controlled by the City of Scottsboro or agencies of the City of Scottsboro.

Section 2. Any employee of the City or its agencies who willfully fails or refuses to follow this ordinance shall be subject to disciplinary action for insubordination and/or refusal to follow a direct order of his or her supervisor.

Section 3. No employee of the City of Scottsboro shall harass or otherwise discriminate or retaliate against any other city employee who seeks to enforce the terms of this ordinance.

Section 4. The smoking or use of cigarettes, cigars, pipes, and

any other tobacco product, be it smokeless or otherwise, shall not be permitted or allowed at any entrance to any building owned, operated, or controlled by the City of Scottsboro or agencies of the City of Scottsboro unless designated as a smoking or tobacco use area by appropriate signage approved prior to posting in writing and signed by the appropriate department head and mayor.

This ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and adoption as provided by law.
