

ORDINANCE NO. 93-5-ADM

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ALL TOBACCO PRODUCTS
IN CITY OF TRUSSVILLE MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Trussville,
Alabama, as follows:


Section 1. Effective June 1, 1993, it shall be unlawful for any person to smoke or carry lighted tobacco or to use smokeless tobacco, in any form, within the enclosed portions of any building used by the City of Trussville for providing municipal services.

Section 2. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause appropriate signs prohibiting the use of tobacco to be erected in all buildings covered under Section 1 of this ordinance.

Section 3. Any person who violates the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall be required immediately to extinguish lighted tobacco or leave the building until such use of tobacco ceases. Failure to comply with this requirement subjects the violator to prosecution, and upon conviction thereof, to punishment within the limits and as provided by the Code of Alabama for municipal ordinance violations.


Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective June 1, 1993 following its adoption and publication as provided by law.
