



WANTED: Interns for the Alabama Department of Public Health

Brief description of organization: The Alabama Department of Public Health (ADPH) is the primary state health agency for the state of Alabama. The mission of ADPH is to promote, protect, and improve Alabama's health.

Paid or Unpaid Internship: Most internships are volunteer based and for school credit, but some can be paid if the hosting program has adequate funding. Paid internships must be discussed with the hosting program and additional documents will be required. ADPH determines the rate of pay based on semester hours completed per class: 11917 State Intern, Grade 5057.

Desired Education Level: Undergraduate or graduate students in good standing at an accredited college or university.

Location: Interns may be placed at our central office location in the RSA Tower in Montgomery or at one of our county offices. At this time, all internships are in person; we do not offer remote or web-based internship options. Mobile and Jefferson counties place their own interns, so please contact those counties directly if you are interested in an internship placement there.

How to Apply: Interested students should submit a cover letter, resume, geographical location of interest and program interest to internships@adph.state.al.us.
